

CULLMAN ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE LINE EXTENSION POLICY SUMMARY

ALL SERVICES

Cullman Electric Cooperative's point of electrical service delivery will be within (5) five feet of the point on, or adjacent to, the structure to be served which is nearest the cooperative's existing or proposed facilities.

HOME

Must be long-term permanent type structure residential load
First 600 ft. at no cost, next 600 ft. at \$3.16
All line footage over 1,200 ft. at \$6.33

For Underground the member must pay difference between overhead and underground service

Underground primary cost difference = \$7.12 ft (all footage)

Underground secondary cost difference = \$350 for the first 100 feet.
All footage in excess of 100 at \$2 per ft.

MOBILE HOME

If the mobile home (camper & travel trailers not included) is to be the primary residence of the person requesting service and the person owns the mobile home, owns the property, has appropriate water and sewer/septic installed, the line will be extended as described above for a HOME.

MOBILE HOME

If person requesting service does not; intend for the mobile home to be their residence, owns the property; does not have appropriate water, septic/sewer; or the service is to be listed in the name of someone else, the cost will be calculated as follows:

First 100 ft. free - All footage over 100 ft. at \$6.33 per ft.

MISC. SERVICE

Barns, shops, campers, travel trailers, etc. First 100 ft. free.

All footage over 100 ft. at \$6.33 per ft.

Underground - Member to pay cost difference between overhead and underground service as described above.

COMMERCIAL

In all cases of commercial service, load information must be furnished prior to design and construction of project.

Single phase - Same policy as described above for HOME

Three phase - Same policy as described above for HOME plus cost difference between single phase and three phase construction

For underground service add the cost difference between underground and overhead construction.

SUBDIVISION

Must furnish plot plan, showing street rights of way and names, permanent lot lines and numbers. Also, must furnish easement. Developer pays \$6.33 ft. for backbone, refundable on per lot basis if connected within 5 years. Will refund up to 600 ft. per lot.

TRAILER OR CAMPER PARK

Must furnish plat of project. First 1,200 ft at \$3.16/ft. all other at \$6.33/ft.

LINE RELOCATION

Total cost of project

MEMBER MUST CUT ALL RIGHTS-OF-WAY AND SECURE ANY EASEMENTS
